



News letter – inpay updates

Preface:

This document describes recent updates to Merchant API and administration GUI.

Due to backward compatibility no obligatory changes are derived from this upgrade.

Please read our latest Merchant API documentation for full technical details.

Merchant API:

Version

Version has been added to API calls to distinguish between different API versions.

Parameter

All API calls accept **version** as an optional parameter.

Settings

API Version has been added to merchant settings.

For all existing merchants it has been set to "1.0.0".

New merchants will not need to set it (default is latest).

Existing merchants are advised to upgrade to new version.

New invoice status

Invoice status is unified to the following values:

"pending", "sum_too_low", "approved", "cancelled" and "refunded".

Changes from previous version

Invoice status

“pending” is replacing “created”

How to upgrade?

1. Make sure your post-back handler can handle “pending” status (does not expect “created”).
2. Contact our support to upgrade your setting

New feature: get_banks

We have added a new feature to the merchant api: get_banks. This lets you retrieve an xml list of all our banks, and what countries they operate in. This is usefull if you want to display a “We support these banks” list, and do not want to maintain it manually.

Administration GUI

New features and configuration options have been added to the administration GUI.

Help text

At the top of each page you will find this icon: 

Clicking it will provide you with the help information for a specific page.

Notification

Merchant can ask to be notified (or notify buyer) upon changes in payment (invoice) status.

Notification can be delivered via e-mail or HTTP post back.

Merchant can add, update and delete notification.

Notification is accessible via the “*Notification Settings*” tab available on edit-merchant form.

Merchant Setting Tabs

New configuration tabs are available in edit-merchant form.

Notification settings Tab

Buyer Settings Tab

Include layout and display parameters

General Tab

Include permissions and filters sparameters.
